

KY-TN CPH Advantage-60 SelectVAC Sale Guidelines

December 5, 2011 and January 23, 2012

- The Guthrie sales **will no longer** be source and age verified/PVP.
- Cattle must be **weaned 60 days** prior to sale.
- **Management Requirements:**
 - Owned by seller a minimum of 60 days
 - Weaned a minimum of 60 days**
 - Trained to eat from a bunk and drink from a trough
 - Dehorned and healed (no visible horns or scurs)
 - Males castrated and healed; no stags, scrotal sac must have fallen off banded calves
 - Heifers are guaranteed open and steers are guaranteed not to be bulls. A refund of \$200 per head will be paid *by the seller* to the buyer for any bred heifers or intact males.
 - One owner pens may sell intact if they are a load lot of like cattle.
- **Mineral Requirement:** Calves must have access to a free choice mineral supplement which contains a minimum of:
 - 1,400 ppm copper (no copper oxide)
 - 26 ppm selenium
 - 3,000 ppm zinc
 - 3,000 ppm manganese
- **Health Requirement: (Only Pfizer Animal Health products can be used)**

- **County Agent Information**

- **Obtain tags and CPH health certificates** by contacting your county extension agent. Tags cost \$1.50 each.
- **Your local county extension agent must physically inspect your cattle** and verify that calves are weaned, vaccinated and on the required mineral program. Be prepared to show documentation (vet supply receipts and mineral tags) to your county agent that this has been done.
- **Return completed copy of CPH health certificates to your county extension agent** by **November 21** for the December sale and **January 9** for the January sale.
