ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP
FOR FAMILY & CONSUMER SCIENCES STUDENT**

For many years KEHA has given scholarships to high school students and grants to members and agents for study and projects. Beginning in 2007, there will be a new scholarship at the University of Kentucky. An endowed scholarship has been established with the help of the College of Agriculture. This scholarship will be given to a person who plans to pursue a career as a Family & Consumer Sciences Extension Agent. The scholarship is our effort to help educate new FCS agents who will benefit the entire state.

Rules and regulations governing the Family & Consumer Sciences Scholarship

- A. The scholarship(s) will be awarded to students who:
- Plan to pursue a career as a Family & Consumer Sciences Extension Agent within the state of Kentucky,
 - Have a junior or senior standing in the School of Human Environmental Sciences within the College of Agriculture,
 - Are in good academic standing with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in the School of Human Environmental Sciences within the College of Agriculture,
- B. Recipients of the scholarship will be allowed to use the award for regular semester coursework and/or an internship for course credit in Family and Consumer Sciences Cooperative Extension within a county Cooperative Extension office in the state of Kentucky.
- C. A student who received the scholarship as a junior may apply for renewal as a senior if a cumulative GPA of 3.0 is maintained.
- D. The scholarship application form will be available in December on the College of Agriculture website at www.ca.uky.edu/students.
