Campbell Co. 4-H Saddle-Up Club Show Rules

- **Campbell County Saddle-Up Club, leaders, CCAS Inc., Northern Kentucky Saddle Club, or others are not responsible for accidents or loss of equipment.**
- Photographs of participants and spectators may be taken during the horse show and may be used by Campbell County 4-H for promotional purposes in print and on the World Wide Web.
- **Registration booth** opens 1 hour before the show starts. Entry fee \$6.00 per class plus a \$3.00 gate fee for each horse registered. **Current negative Coggins is required.** Registration for the first 3 classes closes 15 minutes before starting time. Once the show has started, the classes will close upon completion of the second class prior. Tack change is limited to 5 minutes; **horse or rider must be in consecutive classes.** Show Management may cancel any classes at their discretion and/or if they deem conditions are unsafe.
- **No refund after a contestant has entered a class unless the class is cancelled or suspended by Show Management.** (See refund policy at registration booth.) No fee may be switched to another class. ****Classes with \$50, \$100 or \$150 pay back require 10 entries.** All other classes require 6 entries to receive pay back.
- ***4-H State and Club rules apply to classes with asterisk (*).** **Judge's Decision Is Final!**
- Proper attire is required for all classes. **ASTM-SEI helmet is required with safety strap fastened for all riders/drivers, 18 years & under (as of January 1, current year), in all classes and whenever riding/driving on show grounds. Boots required.** All participants & judge will follow dress code of state rules except for Contest riders (at club shows only) may wear a **short sleeved collared button-down shirt – western attire or Polo shirt. No T-shirts. No sleeveless collared button-down shirts - Shirts must be tucked in. No mid-torso showing.**
- **OPEN CLASS dress code** – same as above with the exception of participants 19 years and older (as of January 1 of the current year) are **strongly recommended to wear an ASTM-SEI helmet.**
- **Riders/drivers age as of January 1st** determines the class eligibility. **Junior** riders (age -13) may not ride in upper age categories. **Senior** riders (age 14-18) may not ride in lower age categories.
- **Walk-Trot:** if showing in any walk-trot class participant can only show in showmanship or other in-hand class. Participant cannot show in any class which asks for a lope or canter or any jumping class. (Club Rule)
- **Contest showmanship class** –Horse and rider must be entered together in other contest classes.
- No Stallions. No exceptions. Uncontrolled or sick horses will be asked to leave.
- **No Dogs on grounds. No alcohol. No Glass Bottles** of any kind. Proper etiquette required at all times. **Concessions** are available on grounds.
