Horse (Sheena Thomas-Brown) - 4-H members can attend D7 horse judging at Murray and get 1 hour of their certified hours, however their certified leader must attend for them to get the credit. Horse Camp forms are officially out. RV hookups will be through lottery again this year. Paperwork must be in May 1 and certified hours must be received by April 30.
