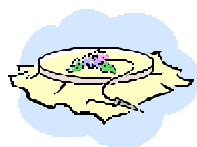


## CUMBERLAND COUNTY EXTENSION HOMEMAKERS FEBRUARY/MARCH 2008, NEWSLETTER

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### Cultural Arts Competition



The Cumberland County Extension Homemakers' Cultural Arts Competition will be held on Friday, February 15 at the new Ag Expo Building, located on Upper River Street in Burkesville. Set up for the event will be at 8:00 entries will be accepted beginning at 9:00 and continuing through 11:00 o'clock. Judging will be from 11:00 to 2:00 with the Cultural Arts viewing open to the public from 2:00 to 4:00. Your list of categories are enclosed. If you need another list of entries, call the Extension Office, or see your president. Mrs. Peggy Branham and Mrs. Sandra Morgan are the County Cultural Arts Chair Persons. Assisting them on that day will be Linda Spears, Becky Cary and Cathy Berry. If you would like to help they would be glad to share the work, call Sandra or Peggy to let them know you are coming. Be there by 8:00 to set up.

Ribbons will be awarded for first, second and third place in each category. The Viewers Choice Ribbon will also be awarded. This is voted on by people that will be attending the viewing. The categories are basically the same as last year. A list is enclosed. You can enter one item in each sub-category. You can't enter an item that has won a blue ribbon in the Cumberland County Cultural Arts Competition in the past. Each article must be the work of the homemaker member and must have been completed during the past two years.

The Area Cultural Arts competition will also be held in February on Friday the 22nd in Casey County. Entries will be those items that won blue ribbons in the County Competition and your President Cathy Berry will be taking those winning items to the contest. The Area Cultural Arts Competition is **not open for viewing**, since counties want to take their entries home when competition is completed.
