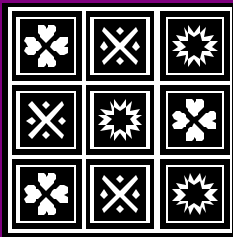

#### Smoked Sausage and Green Beans (Crock Pot) Thanks to Cindy Jo Nettles; Station #2 Club

- \* 68 potatoes, peeled and cut in fourths
