



ANY CANVAS NEEDLEPOINT CLASS

Intermediate Class

October 6, 20, November 3, 17 from 10 am-Noon

An any canvas class is one in which the student brings a painted canvas of her/his choice and some threads. Then the instructor helps bring the canvas to life with thread and stitch suggestions, diagrams and assistance with proper stitching techniques.

This is NOT a class for beginners. Students must have a basic knowledge of needlepoint and know how to properly work the Basketweave Stitch. Being able to read a graph is helpful but not required. With this type of class, not only do the students learn from their own projects, but from the projects of their classmates as well.

Requirements for the class:

A painted needlepoint canvas mounted on appropriate-sized stretcher bars with tacks (a suggestion for this 4-week class session would be an ornament or small picture)

Some threads to work with (not all threads are needed for the first class. We will discuss what you will need)

Tapestry needles, scissors, pencil and notebook

Magnification, if needed

An urge to learn

Class minimum 6 people, maximum 8 people
