Winners of each age group will receive a ribbon and a medal. In addition they can receive a full scholarship to 4-H camp June 24-26th at North Central 4-H Camp or a 4-H prize pack! (Only one camp scholarship can be awarded per child.)

4-H Speech Contest

The 4-H Speech Contest is your first opportunity to win a free trip to camp! You will write and prepare a speech to give on any topic of your choice. On January 31st, at 6:00 p.m. you will give your speech to a panel of judges and guests. Youth, ages 9-13, must do a speech for 3-5 minutes. Youth, ages 14-19, must perform a speech for 5-7 minutes. The speech can be on any subject of your choice. Youth compete with other youth of the same age. They may only have note cards to do the speech; no other visual aides are permitted. It's easy!!! Please send the 4-H speech contest registration form in before January 30th to get entered into the contest! 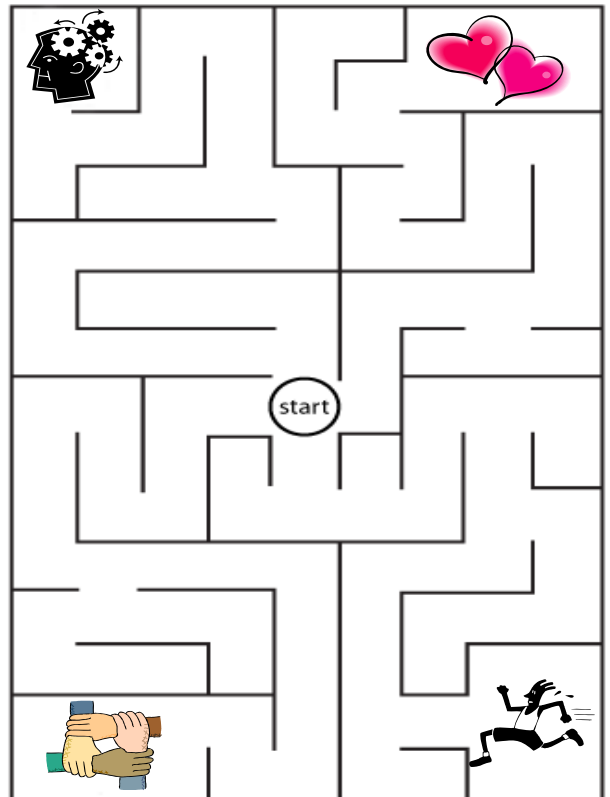
4-H Summit Kentucky Leader- ship Center March 6-8

Delegates choose from several interest areas including leadership, communications and citizenship. Objectives are accomplished through hands on active workshops, guest speakers, seminars, group living, recreation, and recognition. Kentucky 4-H Note card Contest Help design a Kentucky 4-H Note Card!

The state is full of creative individuals who have lots of artistic abilities. It is now time for Kentuckians to display these talents by participating in the 4-H Note Card Contest. The contest is open to 4-H members, volunteers, and parents and is divided into four separate age categories. These categories are young junior, 9-10-years-old; junior, 11-14; senior, 15-19 and adult, over 19.

Use your creativity when designing a note card. 4-H means different things to many people. The note cards should be representative of the Kentucky 4-H program and the youth and adults involved and should be submitted on a standard size sheet of white paper. Some possible themes include 4-H activities, character building, self-discipline, leadership, healthy living and acceptance.

County winners will be displayed from Feb. 21-23, 2008 at the Kentucky 4-H Volunteer Forum in Lexington. Forum participants will vote to determine state winners. Once submitted, the artwork becomes the property of the Kentucky 4-H Youth Development Program and will not be returned.

Artwork may be submitted in color and can be hand lettered, stenciled or computer illustrated. Designs should be generic and void of any words or phrases such as "Thank you." Designs that are specific to a particular county will not be accepted.

Sample artwork from past winners, registration forms and other information are available at the Franklin County Extension Office. All entries are due by **Friday January 25th.**

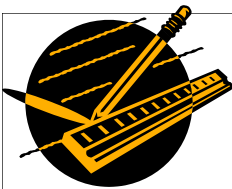
