**Dry Ridge/Williamstown** (From I-75, Exit 156 Barnes Road. Turn east onto Barnes Road; turn north onto US 25; market is located on left.) OPENS 8:00 AM DAILY (limited Sundays) DURING SEASON.

→ All members of the Grant County Farmer's Market (GCFM) are residents of Grant County. All items are grown and harvested in Grant County.

→ Two convenient locations both on US 25. One at Crittenden next to the Whippy Dip. One near the old County Bus Garage between Dry Ridge and Williamstown (see directions in this brochure).

→ Home-grown items that you can rest assured; anything you purchase at the GCFM is produced right here in Grant County.

→ Baked goods from Grant County. Throughout the season goods at both our convenient locations are compliant with Kentucky Home-based Processor and Micro-processor Requirements.

→ Participating in WIC and Seniors FMNP (Farmers' Market Nutrition Program). We accept WIC and Senior Program checks for qualifying foods.
