

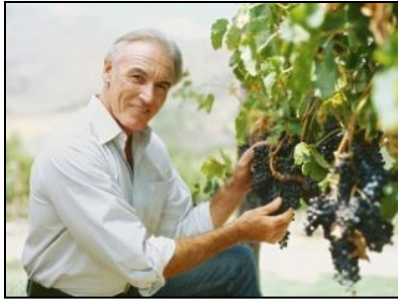

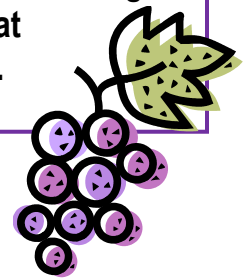


Area grape enthusiasts have the unique opportunity to attend a fall seminar conducted by one of University of Kentucky's leading authorities on grape production, Dr. John Strang. The seminar will be held at the Grayson County Extension Office on Saturday, September 26<sup>th</sup>, 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. The presentation will focus on topics associated with planning a vineyard for both wine and table grapes. Selected topics include site selection, soil type, selecting grape varieties, planting, trellis selection and construction, vineyard management, disease and insect control, pruning, and harvest.

The cost to attend the seminar is \$8.00, and will include a copy of Dr. Strang's publication, "Growing Grapes in Kentucky."
