Archery – Tuesdays 5:00 at Ag Park

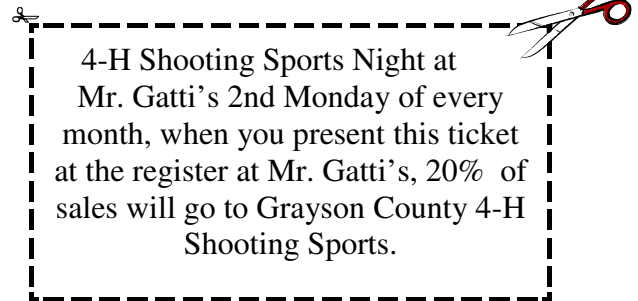
Pistol – 1st & 3rd Saturday of each month at Ag Park from 9-11

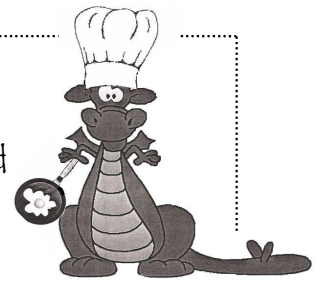

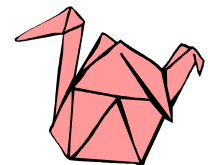

The winning card design will be printed as our office Christmas card.

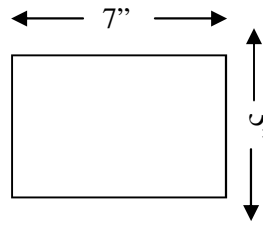
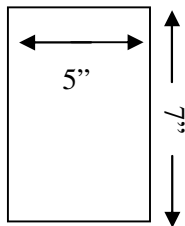
Rules are simple:
