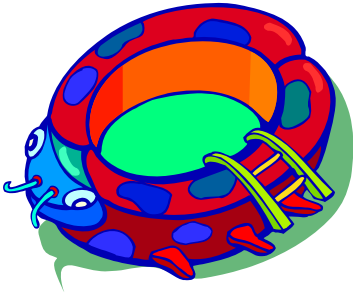

Trap– Mondays 5:00 at Leitchfield Sportsman's Club located off HWY 737

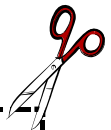
Archery– Tuesdays 5:00 at Ag Park

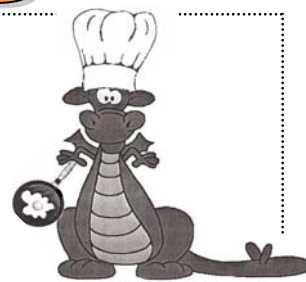
