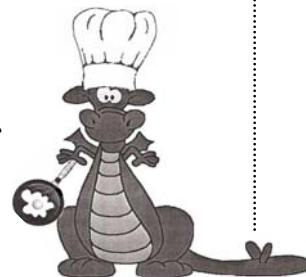
# Frying Dragons
