JANE TODD CRAWFORD QUILT TRAIL GUIDELINES

1. Each block must be 8 x 8 or 4 x 4 to be placed on the quilt trail. 4 x 4 blocks have the option to be on the quilt trail. All 8 x 8 blocks will be on the quilt trail.
2. Quilt blocks must be a pieced or appliqué pattern approved by the Jane Todd Crawford Committee. Once a pattern has been chosen, it is unique to the quilt trail. No duplicate patterns will be allowed.
3. Quilt blocks will be painted on approved signboard by the Jane Todd Crawford Committee.
4. Quilt block must be placed on a COMMITTEE approved barn, building or other location.
5. The local committee will make the necessary contacts to schedule the hanging of the block. Please understand that we are at the mercy of our partner, Taylor County RECC, and they will hang it as soon as they can. Weather, time of year, and other situations out of our control may delay hanging. Expect a longer time frame in the colder months.
7. Each participant will get to preview their quilt block on a 2 x 2 block BEFORE the final quilt is painted to ensure the pattern and colors are correct. All 2 x 2 blocks are property of the Jane Todd Crawford Quilt Trail and cannot be sold under any circumstance.
