Alfalfa - Learn how to raise alfalfa hay for livestock.
Animal Care - Learn basic care of animals.
Beef - Learn fitting, showing and marketing.
Bicycle - Learn basic maintenance and care of your bicycle.
Bread - Learn the fine art of baking breads, compete in the 4-H Bake-Off.
Corn - Learn about raising corn and start your own corn project for the fair.
Crochet - Beginning crochet to advanced projects such as afghans.
Dairy - Learn about pure bred dairy animals and their management.
Dairy Foods - Learn the importance of dairy products while using easy recipes.
Dairy Goats - Learn proper care of Dairy Goats.
Dogs - Learn how to help train your dog and participate in a Dog Show.
Forestry - Learn tree and leaf identification. Make a leaf collection.
General Cooking - Learn preparation, safety and nutrition.
Growing House Plants - Learn how to grow and care for indoor house plants.
