“KIDS 4 KIDS” APPLICATION

The Tri-State Goat Producers Association would like you to one of the first to apply for our new KIDS 4 KIDS program. This program has been started in order to help generate more interest in goats among the youth in Tri-State. There are youngsters throughout the Tri-State that have shown interest in owning a goat, but have been unable to purchase one for one reason or another. Next Spring, 2008, the Tri-State Goat Producers Association have donated 5 goat doe kids and hopefully a few more to come. These will be given to the same number of youth as kids donated. The recipients will be chosen by a combination of the club's members and the breeders who made the donations. Applicants must be at least 9 years old and under 19 years old. The applicants will need to have adequate shelter, (barn, garage, shed, or something to use for shelter) for the animal. Applicants should be able to provide anything that the goat may need such as grain, hay, water, and a veterinarian if needed. The recipient will be required to breed the animal when she reaches breeding age. Several of our breeders are willing to help with this. The recipient has to agree to donate the first kid(s) back into the program to be donated to another child, or the the TSGPA to do with as they see necessary. Recipients also have to agree to participate in at least one of the scheduled goat shows during the 2008 season. Club members are willing to help you with transportation if needed. Once these obligations are met, the goat is entirely yours. Applications must be postmarked my March 1, 2008. We will be contacting the winners in early April and awarding the goats on April 15th at our regular scheduled meeting at 7:00 pm at the Boyd County Fairgrounds.
