Vegetables How Long Until Harvest?

The following table will help you to estimate how long it will take before you can harvest your crop, once flowering has occurred. The number listed is the number of days after pollination for crops growing under warm conditions.

Vegetable	Time to Maturity (Days)
Beans	7-10
Corn, Sweet	18-23
Cucumber, Pickling	4-5
Cucumber, Slicing	15-18
Eggplant	25-40
Muskmelon	42-46
Okra	4-6
Pepper, green stage	45-55
Pepper, red stage	60-70
Pumpkin, large varieties	80-90
Pumpkin, small varieties	65-75
Squash, Summer Crookneck	6-7
Squash, Summer Straightneck	5-6
Squash, Summer Zucchini	3-4
Squash, Winter Butternut	60-70
Squash, Winter Acorn	55-60
Tomato, mature green stage	35-45
Tomato, red ripe stage	45-60
Watermelon	42-45
