WHAT: Ambassadors will receive intensive training to build their leadership and communication skills. Participants will prepare, practice and then have opportunities to present a 4-H speech. Ambassadors will go into the community to help “tell the 4-H story”. 4-H will schedule one or two speaking engagements
