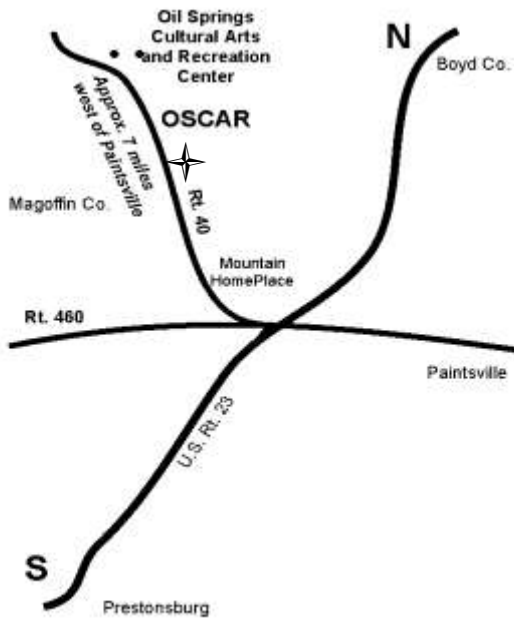

Oil Springs Cultural Arts and Recreation (OSCAR) Center is now considered a cultural heritage center, offering area artisans a place to teach and participate in many artistic classes. OSCAR also provides an opportunity for the public to view products made exclusively by these artisans

The center, also, displays artifact collections, pottery, has a local history study room, arts and crafts library, a recycle clothing shop, woodshop, theatre, and workshop.
