



London-Laurel County Farmers Market

2012 Guidelines

- The 2012 market season will begin on Saturday, April 28, and end on Saturday, October 27.
- Dues for the 2012 season will be as follows:
 - Shelter spaces—\$50/year
 - Parking lot spaces—\$30/year
 - Daily rate for a parking lot space—\$10/day
- Membership cards must be worn or displayed by all vendors during market sales.
- The market will be open on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays beginning at 7 AM. Vendors under the shelter must be set up no later than 9 AM on sale days or the space can be rented to someone else for that day.
- Vendor spaces are available only to Laurel County farmers and producers.
- All produce must be home-grown in Laurel County. Producers who have farms in Laurel County that extend into an adjoining county will be permitted to sell their produce at the market.
- To sell home-canned foods, the producer is required by law to have the necessary permits from the Health Department and the products must be labeled appropriately. (Refer to Kentucky HB 391.)
- No set-up will be allowed before 6 AM.
- Saturday sales will end at noon or when supplies are gone.
- The sale or give-away of animals is strictly prohibited.
- Sales of locally made craft items will be permitted on Saturdays and special sale dates.
- Producers are responsible for the clean-up of the general area they use each week.
- Vendors will provide a list of no more than three (3) individuals who will be permitted to operate the booth in the absence of the vendor who holds the membership for that booth.
- These guidelines are subject to revision as needed by the Farmer's Market Planning Committee.
