**HERE ARE JUST A FEW FACTS
TO THINK ABOUT BEFORE
YOU TOSS YOUR NEXT PIECE OF TRASH!**

- * Enough energy is saved by recycling one aluminum can to run a TV set for three hours or to light one 100 watt bulb for 20 hours.
- * You can make 20 cans out of recycled material with the same amount of energy it takes to make one new one.
- * Five recycled plastic bottles make enough fiberfill to stuff a ski jacket.
- * In this decade, it is projected that Americans will throw away over 1 million tons of aluminum cans and foil, more than 11 million tons of glass bottles and jars, over 4 and a half million tons of office paper and nearly 10 million tons of newspaper. Almost all of this material could be recycled.

CRITERIA FOR SCULPTURES

- * Must demonstrate unique use of materials.
- * Must be free standing and stay intact when moved.
- * Cannot measure more than 24" in any direction and cannot weigh more than 15 pounds.
- * All materials except adhesive must be recycled or reused.
- * Must have been completed since November 2008.
- * Student must be resident of Caldwell, Crittenden, Livingston, Lyon, Marshall, or Trigg Counties.
- * **Entry Form attached to sculpture.**

- * Sculptures judged on variety of materials, creativity, overall appearance and entry form.
- * Ties broken by the number of different materials.
