WHAT? 4-H CAMP! 4-H Camp has one primary objective: "To educate boys and girls in the art of living." In other words, 4-H Camp is fun activities designed to aid you in meeting many of your personal developmental needs.

WHY? IT'S FUN! IT'S EDUCATIONAL! 4-H Camp gives you the opportunity to participate in activities such as boating, horseback riding, softball, swimming, rifle, archery, arts and crafts, Field Olympics, and many more exciting events.

HOW? RETURNING THE REGISTRATION FORM! The cost of 4-H Camp this year is \$160.00. You still have time to sign up, but there is a limited number of Marshall County 9-13 year olds that can go, because of the spaces available at camp. So don't delay. **Don't forget there is a \$25.00 payment due with the registration form to ensure you a camp space. This payment must be included with registration or your registration will be sent back.** The payment does get applied towards the \$160 fee.

Due to problems in recruiting cabin leaders, everyone will be placed on a waiting list. As we find an adult to serve as a cabin leader, you will be placed in a cabin. Early registration will be important because each form is numbered as it is turned in. The first ones registering will be the first ones taken off the waiting list.

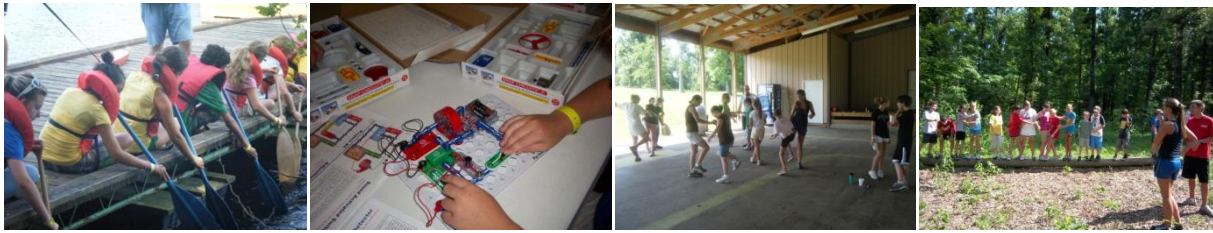

4-H Camp is a great opportunity for you to relax and have fun with friends and other 4-Hers your own age. Camp allows you a chance to participate in a variety of fun and educational activities.

You'll stay in cabins with other people your age, at least one teen counselor, and an adult counselor. Campers sleep in bunk beds with real mattresses! Bathhouse facilities include showers, toilets, sinks and even hot water!

The cost of camp this year is \$160.00. Not bad since this includes your camp t-shirt, meals, lodging, transportation, and much more. Extra spending money can be brought for souvenirs or classes.
