



Mercer County 4-H Scholarship Application Guidelines

Mercer County 4-H Council will award two \$500 scholarships or four \$250 scholarships pending on number of qualified applicants.

Qualified Applicants:

1. Must be a current Mercer County 4-H member.
2. Must be a resident of Mercer County.
3. Only high school graduating seniors are eligible.
4. Maintained at least a 3.0 G.P.A.
5. Plan to attend a technical school or college.

Scholarship Committee comprised of leaders from the Mercer County 4-H Council will make the selection. Decisions of the committee are final.

Scholarship will be awarded to the recipient in the following manner:

Half of the total scholarship will be awarded for each semester.

Mercer County 4-H Council will have a drop-out rule:

Recipient must complete the first semester, if not, they must reimburse the first installment to the 4-H Council. Also, the remaining balance will not be awarded if the student fails to enroll in a higher education program.
