HISTORIC PEG BARN

Tour a historic peg barn and listen to the owners' stories. Get an up-close view of a mural depicting cutting tobacco and learn details about Owen County's unique Agricultural Heritage Trail project.

FORSEE SOUTHDOWN SHEEP FARM
