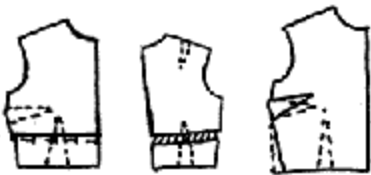


Annette's Christmas Quilt
