### March 5, 2009-Growing Seedless Grapes

Dr. John Strang fruit Specialist from U.K. will teach you how to grow fresh seedless table grapes better than the ones sold in stores! Register by February 20, Limit 20 participants. The cost is \$15.00 per person which includes supper and a grape vine to try at home.

### March 19, 2009-Growing a Spring Vegetable Garden

You will learn all about planting a spring vegetable garden. We will discuss most crops for spring including potatoes, peas, carrots, beets, cole crops, onions, lettuce, radish, etc. All participants will receive a spring garden starter kit complete with seeds, plants, and tubers. Limit 20 participants and registration required by March 6. Cost is \$10.00.



### April 2, 2009- Growing Strawberries

Learn how to grow strawberries at home. All participants will receive 25 plants to start your own strawberry patch. Register by March 20, limit 30 participants. Cost \$5.00, we will have strawberry shortcake!



### April 16, 2009-Gardening Greener

We will discuss limited use pesticides, sustainable gardening practices, and low impact ways of gardening. This isn't just a class on organics! Register by April 3.



### April 30, 2009-Growing Nut Trees

You will learn what types of nuts you can grow in Kentucky as well as which varieties you will be most successful with. There will be samples of several nut varieties for you to try. Register by April 20.



### May 14, 2009-Annual Flowers For Kentucky Gardens

Dr. Rebecca Schnelle Floriculture Specialist from U.K. will teach you the best annuals for season long color in Kentucky. Each participant will receive annuals for their gardens! Register by May 8.



### May 28, 2009-Making A Bamboo Trellis

Learn how to lash a bamboo trellis and make one to take home as well. Register by May 15, limit 20 participants. Cost is \$10.00.

### June 25, 2009-Making Leaf Castings

We will make concrete leaf castings to use as garden ornaments or bird baths. Be sure to bring a large leaf such as an elephant ear, canna, or rhubarb etc. Register by June 12. Cost is \$10.00.
